Terms of Use

Historical Archives

Researchers visiting the Foundation to conduct their work are required to take into account and comply with the following:

- Access to and use of archival material are permitted only after consultation with the Head of the Historical Archives.
- Access rights apply solely to archival material that has been classified and catalogued.
- Entry to the storage areas is not permitted.
- Research is carried out in the designated reading room and in the audiovisual viewing area provided for this purpose.
- Smoking, as well as the consumption of food or beverages are not allowed in research areas. Order and quiet must be maintained, and mobile phones must be set to silent mode.
- Digitized archival material may be consulted on computers provided to each researcher for this purpose.
- The Foundation's scientific staff will provide all necessary guidance on how to search for and view documents using the dedicated software.
- Reproduction of material in the form of digital copies is permitted only with the authorization of the Head of the Historical Archives. The reproduction of entire folders is not allowed.
- The reproduction of digital copies is carried out exclusively by the Foundation's staff.
- The publication of any archival material belonging to the Foundation is prohibited without the prior written authorization of the Board of Directors.
- The Foundation's archival material is protected under copyright law. Researchers wishing to make public of items, whose intellectual property rights are not held by the Foundation, bear sole responsibility for identifying the rights holders and obtaining permission (Law 2121/1993).
- Researchers are required to explicitly acknowledge the source of any material drawn from the Foundation's Historical Archive, citing: "Konstantinos K. Mitsotakis" Foundation, along with the specific archive or collection consulted.
- The Foundation cannot be held responsible for any breach of data protection legislation arising from the publication of research based on its archival materials (Law 2472/1997).
- Researchers are kindly requested to submit an electronic or printed copy of any work produced using the Foundation's collections.
